Lt. Col. Betty C. Carroll, 85, of Sterling Heights, formerly of Royal Oak, died March 6, 2008 at Providence Hospital in Southfield. She was born May 27, 1922 in St. Paul, MN. In January 1945, Betty married Raymond Carroll and the Salvation Army assigned them to Saginaw, MI.
