Manuel enjoyed spending time outdoors. He particularly loved fishing, long drives, and traveling-especially vacations spent with his family. He also enjoyed exploring garage sales and attending cookouts where he got to spend time with his relatives.

Manuel was also mechanically inclined and was often repairing cars or any equipment that needed fixing. Most importantly, he was always that to offer a helping hand when needed.

Manuel was always dedicated to his work and family. He will be deeply missed by his friends, family, and all who knew him.
