Peggy Anderson passed away after a very brief illness due to a brain tumor. She was a long-time employee at Comerica Bank (formally Detroit Bank & Trust) working at the Ferndale and Livonia branches. After retiring from Comerica Bank, Peggy kept busy working for several different businesses in the metro area. She was a long-time member of Our Mother of Perpetual Help in Oak Park and previously of St. Mary Magdalen Parish in Hazel Park. Peggy grew up in Detroit until the family moved to Royal Oak when she was in high school. Peggy graduated from St. Anthony High School in Detroit and was an active member of her alumni class.

She was preceded in death by her son Wayne Anderson (2018), her sister and brother-in-law Mary (2018) and Joseph Knight (2009), her parents Jacob (1978) and Lillian (Hayes) Anderson Mennel (1996), her stepfather Frank Mennel (1995), and her ex-husbands Joe Yaney and Don Yaney.
