May 28, 1934 - June 11, 2023

Marguerite Staten spent her lifetime caring for others in her family, in her church and in her community. She was an exceptionally loving mother to her own children, the neighborhood kids, and the schoolchildren she looked out for. She had a welcoming smile with a life-of-the-party personality. Marge never met a stranger she didn't like.

Marguerite Jean Staten was born May 28, 1934 in Detroit, Michigan to the late Earl and Lucille Whitlock. She was the oldest of 13 children. Preceding her in death was four brothers, Earl, Richard, Paul, and Steve, and one sister, Rita Somers.

Marguerite, affectionally known as Marge, attended Christ the King Elementary School and graduated from Immaculate High School in Detroit in 1952. In her early years, she worked with her Uncle Ed at his newspaper stand in downtown Detroit where she met the love of her life, the late LeRoi M. Staten, whom she later married.

Marge lived a full life of service committed to her family, friends, and faith. She was an active member of St. Gregory the Great and worked in the rectory and church. In 1974, she became a member of St. Mary's of Redford Catholic Church where she remained a member for 49 years.

For over 20 years, she worked as a concession manager for the Detroit Red Wings at the Olympia and Joe Louis Arenas. She served for many years as a waitress and hostess at The Montrose, a well-known neighborhood establishment.

One of her most cherished jobs was working at St. Mary's of Redford Grade School as a teacher's aide, lunch mother, library assistant and office coordinator. She also enjoyed working with the beloved Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, sharing meals and enjoying special times with them.

Her family was the joy of her life. Her children enjoyed celebrating her milestone birthdays with elaborate themed parties with extended family, friends and loved ones. She loved to dance and impressed everyone with her smooth dance moves. She was a huge Bruno Mars fan and enjoyed listening to him while tapping her feet and singing along. She enjoyed her annual Frankenmuth bonding trips with her sisters and nieces, a tradition they started almost 30 years ago.

Marge loved working on crossword puzzles in the Detroit Newspaper, watching Jeopardy, various quiz show programs, gardening, and planting flowers. She faithfully prayed the rosary daily at 3:00 p.m.. She dedicated her time volunteering for St. Vincent de Paul, Sisters Home Visitors of Mary, and was an active member of the Knights of Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary Court 196. She frequently donated to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, one of her many favorite charities.

Upon moving to the Fountains at Franklin Senior Community in 2010, she immediately became the star resident and was well-known for the many roles that she played including leading bingo and keno games, serving as the floor captain, and setting up for the onsite Catholic masses. She was dearly missed

by her friends at the Fountains when she recently moved to live with her two daughters.

Marge was loved by many. She leaves to cherish her memory: her beloved daughters, Karen (Hank) Adams, Kathy (Han) Morgan, Michele Brantley, Marleana Staten, Marjorie Staten, Maria Bobo, beloved son, Kevin (Beverly) Speights, and stepson Leroy Staten, Jr.; two sisters, Ilene Pender and Esther Handel; and five brothers, Thomas Whitlock, James (Linda) Whitlock, John (Teresa) Whitlock, Kenneth (Jo Karen) Whitlock, Joseph (Julie) Whitlock, a host of grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, cousins, and a godson.

“ My memory of Mrs. Staten began in the fall of 1978 around late September when I was a student at St. Mary’s of Redford grade school. At the time I never knew her name or even who she was. I just remember walking through the hall and there was this little woman with glasses looking at me and right away said to me “Mr. Rudolph, I’m watching you” and I replied “yes ma’am” while wondering who the heck is this lady and why is she watching me and what did I do. As the days went by every time I would see her in school this lady would greet me with not hi or good morning but “Mr. Rudolph, I’m watching you. It even had gotten to a point that when I’d be walking in the hallway going to my next class and if I saw her before she saw me I would then immediately turn around and go another way to my next class just to avoid her. There was one time I hadn’t seen this lady all day in school, for me that was a great day! I goofed off as kids did back then and then 2:30 came and school let out for the day, I began my walk home down Grandriver towards Greenfield, and right about when I was approaching Montrose I heard someone say “Mr. Rudolph” as I turned around it was that little lady again. Anyway the grade school was serving the famous Hot Dog lunches and this particular time the students were lined up in the gym in front of the kitchen where the lunches were being passed out. I remember being behind Marjorie at that time. As the line moved closer to the kitchen I could see to my horror it was that little lady again, I just wanted to get out of the line and not get my food, but as the line drew closer and closer until Marjorie was next to be served by this lady, and as Marjorie was being served she said to that lady “Hi MOM!” And right then I knew who she was. This lady who was watching me all this time was Mrs. Staten, Michele’s mom! She was that mother bird watching over her girls. As days turned into weeks and weeks to months and months to years..45 years to

be exact I picked up the phone and called Mrs. Staten on her 89th birthday just to say I love you. THIS IS MY MEMORY OF THE WOMAN I KNOW AS "MOMMA BIRD" I have since retired and moved away to Cypress Texas but even then she has crossed my mind throughout the years. To Michele, Marlana, Marjorie and Maria (the thorn in my side) and to the entire Staten family I too will miss her and I'm also saddened by her passing.
