Marilyn Janet Taylor (Koppelman), 96, a resident of Saline, Michigan for 3 years, formerly a resident of Royal Oak, Michigan for 64 years, died August 11, 2022. She was born March 6, 1926 in Highland Park, Michigan to Walter and Estelle Koppelman. She had a sister, Lois Jean Squires, and a brother, Robert Koppelman. Mrs. Taylor was a 1944 graduate of Ferndale Lincoln High School. In 1947, she married Donald Lee Taylor at St. James Church, Ferndale, Michigan. Mr. and Mrs. Taylor were married for 65 years. 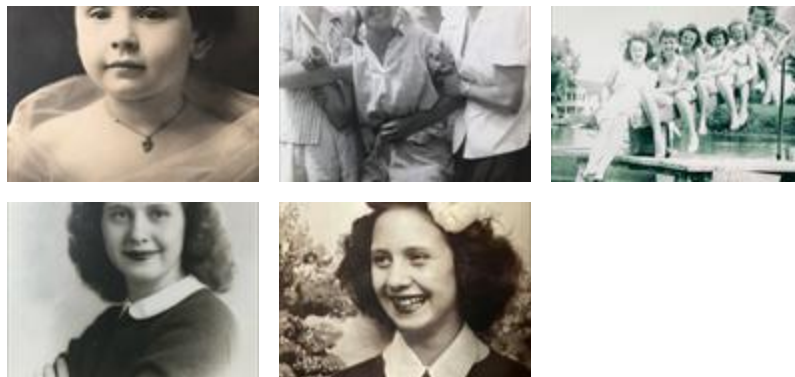
