In 1997, Mary married Roger Angeles, who became her constant companion until his passing in September of 2021. Roger brought more happiness and laughter into Mary's life. They enjoyed dancing and music, and spending time with their grandchildren. Mary was also a wonderful grandmother to Roger's

grandchildren, RG, Victoria, Jacob, Matthew, Ethan, Mia, and Marielle, who affectionately called her Lola Mary.

Although she worked in the private sector for many years, Mary's true passion was teaching. She taught everything from elementary school to university. She was a respected and admired teacher, who inspired and mentored countless students and colleagues. She continued to teach until 2020, when she retired during the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Mary was a devout Catholic, who lived her faith with grace and humility. In 2009, she joined the Franciscan order, and dedicated herself to serving God and His people. She was a member of St. Michael Catholic Community in Sterling Heights. She was a generous and compassionate woman, who always helped those in need, and touched many lives with her kindness.
