

## Mary Ann Ruth Cook

August 26, 1932 - December 14, 2015

Cook, Mary Ann Ruth, age 83, of West Bloomfield, formerly a longtime resident of Royal Oak and Bloomfield Hills, passed away on December 14, 2015. Mary Ann was hard of hearing her entire life, and often mispronounced words, phrases and proper names. These mispronunciations were a source of amusement to both her children and to herself. Mary Ann's favorite television show was "Three's Company", and she'd often laugh herself to tears at the

jokes - even in reruns. She also enjoyed watching cooking shows and classic films, especially those of John Wayne.

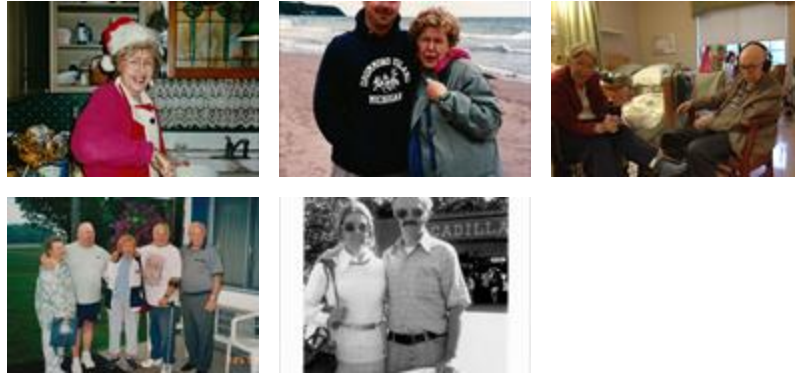
