The relationships that she made with people were genuine. She was so kind and so giving. I always remember how she spoke of her parents. When she spoke of mr. Salter she always called him daddy and not every little girl gets to have a relationship with their daddy where they feel comfortable calling them daddy their whole entire life. She worried about her parents in a way that I wish every child would worry about their parents. When she spoke of her mom she would tell me that those shoes those shoes were so big to fill that all she could do to honor her parents is love them. That's all they wanted from her they showed her unconditional love and she has spread that out into the world tenfold. she worked so hard but always found a way to let somebody else know how proud she was of them, or how interested she was in what they had going on in their life. Not trying to burden anyone with her problems. Mary's soul has touched each and every one of us that knew her in a way that cannot be described, there are no words for what Mary's Soul has done for everyone. Mary Salter was my best friend and she was my biggest fan. After talking to her you would always feel better she would see things in a slightly different light that would give you a different perspective on the situation she was wise Beyond her years and I look forward to being guided buy her love and her light until we meet again.
