Was welcomed by his Lord & Savior into Heaven on November 18, 2025, at the age of 91 years old.

Merle was the beloved husband of Janet Loch for over 70 years. He was also the loving father of three (3) sons, Thomas (Glenna), Robert (Patricia), and Jeffrey (Carol). In addition, he was the proud grandfather (aka, "Pop Pop") to Dane and Kayla Loch as well as Jarrod, Jordan, Jason, Justin, and Jonah Loch. He was preceded into heaven by his parents, Reverend Howard F., and Esther (King) Loch, as well as his older brother Charles, and younger sisters, Iona, and Carolyn. Merle was also the cherished uncle to many nieces and nephews, who each grew up learning a variety of card games from "Uncle Merle."

Merle was known for his vibrant spirit and positive soul and was truly the life of the party at most every family gathering. He was musically gifted and was often the soloist in various church choirs - which he was a member for seventy of his 91 years. Merle was also a gifted musician - playing the piano, trumpet, in addition to his singing talents. Merle's singing began as a member of the Four Tenors, while attending Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) State Teachers College, where he met and married Janet. He was also a proud member of the TKE fraternity.

After completing his undergraduate degree, Merle honorably served as a Captain/Sharpshooter in the United States Army. In addition, he earned his Master of Education (MEd) degree at the University of Michigan, while pursuing his professional career in Education. Merle went on to devote many years to Warren Consolidated Schools (WCS), ultimately serving as the Principal of Warren High School, as well as Sterling Heights High School, prior to his retirement.

Merle's commitment to service extended well beyond his various leadership roles with WCS. Merle was active in the local community as longtime Rotarian and served as its Paul Harris Fellow District Governor for two years. After completing this role, Merle was a regular "Guest Speaker" to various Rotary organizations across southeastern Michigan. Merle also maintained "perfect attendance" with his Rotary commitment -- for over 35 years!
