Frank Michael ("Mike") Druzynski, age 54, of Birmingham, Michigan, passed away July 22, 2017. He was the beloved son of Walli Little and Frank Druzynski, dearest brother of sisters PJ. (Bob) Garner, and Chris (Don) Lashbrook; much-loved uncle of Erin Lashbrook, and loved nephew of Irene McGrath.
