“ I was reminded of Uncle Miles' service maintaining combat planes in Britain in WWII. I was with family in Normandy for the 70th anniversary of the D-Day invasion and was moved to see a C-47 flying over Omaha Beach and the American Cemetery. We later got to tour the plane and meet the crew at an airport in Iceland on its way back to the U.S. We learned that it had dropped paratroopers on D-Day and was later used for medical evacuations, etc. Not sure if Uncle Miles ever worked on any C-47s but am sure he would have been familiar. I'm sorry we never had a chance to talk about it.
