Miles L. Young, age 84, passed away on January 11, 2025 in Royal Oak, Michigan. He was born on August 22, 1940, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late William and Kathleen Young. Miles was the beloved husband of Sharon, with whom he shared a marriage of nearly 60 years, having wed in 1965. 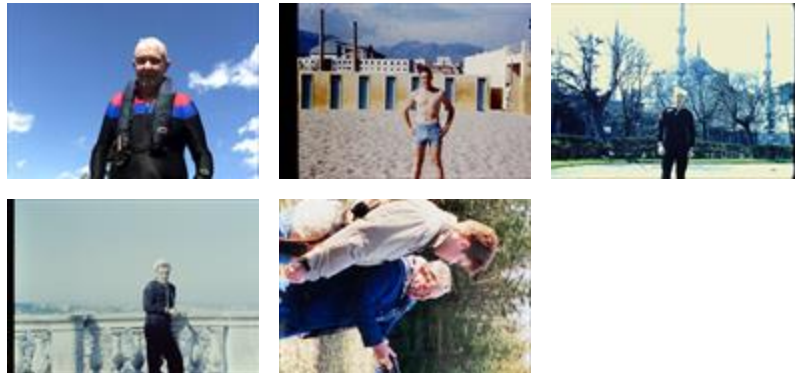
