Molly was a member of the Irish Genealogy Society of Detroit. With her daughter, she wrote a book about her family history entitled "Meet Your Ancestors".

Molly affected countless lives. She was nurturing, loving and always looking to help. She was a member of St. Matthias Parrish for over 50 years, taught

religious education, a member of the Women's Guild, and actively involved in parish activities.

Father Solanus Casey played a big role in Molly's life and was a vital influence on her parents' faith. Molly always supported his legacy thru the Capuchin Soup Kitchen. She was even interviewed by the Archdiocese in regard to his Beatification. Molly lived and loved her Catholic faith and shared it by example with those she met.
