



## Nancy Wujcik

Nancy Frances Wujcik, age 63, passed away suddenly on January 22, 2023 from complications of frontotemporal dementia in Royal Oak, Michigan. She was born September 20, 1959 in Detroit, Michigan. Nancy was the sixth of twelve children born to Edward and Elizabeth Wujcik.

After graduating from Ferndale High School she went on to attend some college at Arizona State University where she excelled in math. Though struggles with mental health kept her from finishing her degree, she was a lifelong learner who loved live music and impressionism. She was beautiful and funny, with a notably genuine smile.

She went on to have a daughter, Megan, whom she loved fiercely. She instilled in her daughter the importance of education, a sense of adventure and a love of nature. They enjoyed walking together at Cranbrook House and Gardens. Nancy was proud to be able to attend her daughter's college graduation and wedding and to become a grandmother in 2021.

Later in life, Nancy celebrated 11 years of sobriety. She received outstanding mental health support through the services of Easterseals Adult Services of Southfield. After experiencing changes in her mobility and speech, she was also diagnosed with frontotemporal dementia.

Nancy is survived by her daughter, Megan Wujcik (Mark Kujawski) and grandson, Theodore. Most recently, she took pleasure in a cold Coca Cola, watching true crime shows and Seinfeld, having sushi with her sister Mary Beth, walking with her daughter and visiting her grandson. It is a comfort to know she is no longer in pain, though she will be deeply missed.
