March 2, 1953 - August 15, 2022

Pamela (Pam) Ann Moultrup, 69, of Royal Oak, Michigan, passed away on August 15, 2022, surrounded by her beloved family.

She was born on March 2, 1953, in Detroit, Michigan. Pam graduated from Royal Oak Kimball High School in 1971 and received a degree in Nuclear Medicine from Oakland Community College. She was dedicated to serving her community through the YMCA Strong Kids Community Campaign, The Marfan Foundation, and Loeys-Dietz Foundation. Pam and Gary were dedicated to supporting those living with a connective tissue disorder through the Detroit Marfan Community.

Pam married Gary, the love of her life, in 1973, who survives her. Pam is also survived by sisters Samantha (Sandi) Lott and spouse Tom, and Paula (Jan) Hill, her sons Joe and spouse Marie, Chris and spouse Ashley, and Brian, as well as grandchildren Jack, Henry, Paxton, and Penelope, and a host of cousins, nieces, and nephews. Pam was predeceased by parents Polly (Mary) and Henry Jessop.

Pam was an avid student of the Food Network and was always found in the kitchen creating culinary masterpieces. This passion recently brought her to the Three Cats Café family in Clawson, MI. Pam's love for community led her to instruct Deep Water Aerobics at the YMCA for many years, where she

challenged her students with laughter, love, and fitness.

Faith was an essential component of Pam's life. She was a Deacon in her church and a staple in the Chancel Choir and Bell Choir for over 50 years. Through the 1970s and '80s, Pam and Gary actively served as Senior High Advisors, which included an annual Dance Club performance that supported Common Ground in Royal Oak, MI.

A visitation will be held on Monday, August 22, 2022, from 2pm to 8pm at Wm. Sullivan & Son Funeral Home, 705 W 11 Mile Road (4 blocks east of Woodward), Royal Oak, MI. A formal service will be held at The First Presbyterian Church of Royal Oak on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, at 10am.
