



## Patricia Ann Eaves

June 9, 1928 - January 25, 2010

Patricia Ann "Pat" Eaves nee Korneffel, age 81, a resident of Troy, formerly a 48-year resident of Royal Oak, died January 25, 2010 at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak. She was born June 9, 1928 in Detroit. Mrs. Eaves was a 1946 graduate of Lincoln High School in Ferndale, a 1948 graduate of Stephens College for Women in Columbia, MO, and a 1975 graduate of Oakland University in Rochester. She married Beecher C. "Bob" Eaves on February 9, 1949 in Pleasant Ridge. Mrs. Eaves was a former PTA president of Northwood Elementary School, Clara Barton School and Dondero High School. She was also a Girl Scout Leader for 10 years. She was a past president of the Royal Oak Woman's Club. She was a member of the Royal Oak Historical Society, Red Hat Society, Red Run Golf and Country Club and the Starr Commonwealth Auxiliary. Mrs. Eaves is survived by her husband, Bob Eaves; children, Pam Mike Koziel of Raleigh, NC and Robert Maria Eaves of Casco, MI; and grandchildren, Elizabeth Jones, Christian Eaves and Allison Koziel. The visitation will be held Thursday 2-8 p.m. at Wm. Sullivan & Son Funeral Home, 705 W Eleven Mile Road 4 blks. E of Woodward, Royal Oak.
