Patricia A. Lindroth, age 85, passed away peacefully Sunday, May 21, 2017. She was born on February 17, 1932 in Lena IL to George and Marjorie (Kaufman) Miller. She earned her B.S. in Education at Northern Illinois State Teachers College (now Northern Illinois State University) in 1954. Shortly after graduation, she moved to Michigan where she taught in the Birmingham Public Schools for over 30 years. She earned an M.A. in Teaching from Oakland University in 1975 and received numerous accolades for her exceptional work ethic and continued pursuit of excellence for herself and her students. She was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church of Birmingham. Her love of choral music led her to join the Chancel Choir singing at Sunday morning worship services for over 30 years. Ever the volunteer, she was involved in varying capacities with Presbyterian Women, Sessions, Archives, Rummage Sale, Phone volunteer, Reading volunteer at Alcott Elementary School, Angel Tree Ministry, as well as baking for numerous FPC gatherings. She was also recognized for her volunteer service with the Epilepsy Center of Michigan. She was an avid gardener and lover of birds and nature, visiting Michigan's many nature centers and state parks. She led a very full, active life which positively impacted those around her. She is survived by three of her four children, Christopher, Jennifer (Jay) Gossett, Catherine (Terrance) Ocheltree, five grandchildren, Pearce, Cole, Justin, Jenna, Joelle, two siblings, Marilyn Miller, Gerald Miller, a cousin Virginia Spurr, and numerous nieces and nephews. She is preceded in death by her
