Have cook outs on a deserted sand bar off the middle channel and swim on the south side of that island because the north side had cold channel water along it's shoreline.

As we neared our late teens and 20's... we saw each other less. She became a hair stylist. I did go to her a few times.... before my life's journey took me south to Cincinnati... and another life!

Knowing that Patty is no longer on this earthly world... makes me sad. Patty had a great personality and huge smile! This world is a smaller place now that she is gone! She is with the Lord now... her job is done. She has been called home!
