March 4, 1939 - February 1, 2020

Paul George Hendrickson, of Sterling Heights, formerly of Clinton Township, passed away at Beaumont Hospital Troy Campus on February 1, 2020 at the age of 80. Paul was born on March 4, 1939 in Detroit, Michigan. During Paul's studies, he received a Bachelor's degree from Wayne State University in Mechanical Engineering, and later a Masters of Business Administration and Finance from Eastern Michigan University. During his time as a mechanical engineer, Paul created two patents to solve a problem with planes crashing. After he changed careers, Paul was a bank controller in Port Huron. After some time as a bank controller, he decided to change careers again and went into commercial real estate. He spent time some time with Century 21 and also worked for Unity Real Estate in Mount Clemens.

During his career, Paul was a member of the Engineering Society of Professional Engineers of Detroit, the Michigan Society of Professional Engineers, the Wayne State Alumni, Sterling Heights Senior Center, Clinton Township Senior Center, and the Kiwanis Club of Clinton Township - where he enjoyed serving meals to the homeless and many volunteer activities. He also volunteered his time at Trinity Lutheran Church in Utica. where he would serve with their community meals for the homeless.

On October 26, 2001, Paul married Martha Jean Hendrickson in Clinton Township. Paul is the cherished husband of 18 years of Martha; the loving father of Lisa (John) Sunday, Heather Brown, and the late Craig Hendrickson, father in law of Amy Hendrickson, the beloved grandfather to three

grandchildren: Katie and Johnny Sunday and Caroline Brown; and the dear brother of Earl (Karen) Hendrickson, Shirley (Neal) Harris, and the late Harold (the late Gloria) Hendrickson. Paul's memorial service is to honor his problem solving abilities and life accomplishments.
