Pearl Emily (Erato) Carson, 95, passed into the loving arms of Our Lord, Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at Bay Bluffs Medical Care Facility, Harbor Springs, Michigan. Her home for the last 4 years.

Pearl was born March 24, 1922 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Samuel Erato and Clara Lemke. Pearl was lovingly raised by her paternal grandparents Anton and Frances Erato.
