Peggy Jean Hughes, loving and cherished mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, left this earthly tabernacle on June 29, 2023, just three days after her 91st birthday. Born in Puryear, Tennessee on June 26, 1932, she lived a determined, hard-working, independent life, where she often said, “You just do what you’ve got to do.”
