He crafted his own garden arbor and picket fence and looked forward to Thanksgiving, his favorite holiday, as it allowed him to prepare a turkey feast with all the trimmings for his loved ones. This annual tradition was important to Randy and something that he took quite seriously. Additionally, Randy was an avid reader with a keen interest in history and science fiction.
