Rebecca Garcia Acevedo, of Pasadena, Texas, passed away on April 27, 2025. A beloved wife, mother, sister, aunt, and abuela, Rebecca will always be remembered for her laugh, quick wit, and willingness to help those in trouble, even strangers.

During retirement, she loved visiting family, checking out garage sales, taking care of neighborhood cats, and volunteering at her church's pantry.

Rebecca will be remembered as the beloved wife of Jorge M. Acevedo (married: May 16, 1971), loving mother of Jorge I. (Jennifer) Acevedo, and proud abuela (grandmother) of Antonio and Alejandro Acevedo.
