He was the only brother to Barb (Bill) Brown, Joyce (Butch) Butcher and Kathy (George) Baalerud as well as the cousin, nephew, and uncle to a large extended family.

Rick was the owner of Billings Lawn Equipment, a store that has been in the Johnson family since the 1950's and continues to be run by his son. He made countless contributions to the city he loved so much Royal Oak. Rick was the past president of the Royal Oak Chamber of Commerce, a past board member of the Royal Oak Boys and Girls Club, past president of the Downtown Royal Oak Association just to name a few. He was instrumental in the annual Grand National car race benefiting Give A Christmas, was a founding sponsor of the Royal Oak Sandlot baseball team, as well as a longtime hockey and bowling team sponsor.
