Wm. Robb Webster, age 72, of Royal Oak, passed away on April 10, 2025.

Robb spent his early years in Garden City where he attended St. Raphael Grade School. He was an altar boy, always happy to pick up a little extra cash, volunteering to serve at weddings and funerals. At a young age Robb stepped into a provider role and helped to look out for his younger brothers and sister.
