Obituary for Robert William "Bill" Burt

His commitment to his community was evident through his extensive volunteer work; Bill was a Cub Scout Master for an impressive 20 + years and an active member of the Dad's Club, touching countless lives with his guidance and enthusiasm.

Bill's infectious personality shone brightly in every interaction. He was known for being playful and chronically sarcastic, always ready to strike up a conversation with anyone, whether they liked it or not. He found immense joy in simply being around his family, creating cherished memories that will be held dear.

Bill is survived by his devoted wife, Barbara, and his five loving sons, Steve (Malissa), Jeff, Scott, Jamie, and Jason (Kim).
