Robert Michael Fagan, age 77, of Royal Oak, passed away on December 19, 2023.

Bob was born in Detroit on April 2, 1946. A proud Vietnam Veteran, he served with the U.S. Army after high school and then returned to the Detroit area to begin his career. He ultimately retired from Grand Trunk Railway after 20+ years as an accountant with the company.

Bob was a passionate volunteer who generously gave his time to a variety of organizations. Within Detroit itself, he volunteered with a sandwich ministry that provided meals to the homeless in the city, as well with at least two clinics: a dental clinic hosted at St. Leo's and one at the Center for the Works of Mercy, run by Catholic Charities. A devout Catholic, Bob was also devoted to his church, contributing many hours of his time to St. Mary Catholic Church in Royal Oak.

When he wasn't volunteering, Bob loved to read. He especially enjoyed anything to do with history or architecture. And, undoubtedly, a favorite part of his week was meeting up with his "Coney Friends" at Leo's in Royal Oak once or week, where they would discuss anything and everything. He will be dearly missed.

Bob is survived by his daughter, Shawn (John) Webster; his grandchildren: Liam, Annabelle, and Owen; his siblings: Colleen (Gerald) Marcus and Sister Mary Shawn Fagan; and forty-three loving nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his siblings: William Fagan, Eileen Cauley, Mary Lou Borgne, Ellen Ritter, Patrick Fagan, Leo Fagan, Tom Fagan, and Ruth Ann.
