



## Robert Finnerty

September 16, 1929 - January 31, 2026

Robert Gerard Finnerty, age 96, died peacefully on January 31, 2026.

Robert was born in Rouyn, Quebec, Canada, on September 16, 1929. He immigrated to the United States in 1951, became a proud American citizen, and joined the United States Army, where he served honorably for three years.

In 1956, he married Leona “Lee” Bojarski, with whom he shared many happy years until her passing in 1993. Robert began his career with General Motors Overseas Operations and later became a successful businessman in the typesetting and commercial arts industry. He was the owner of Total Business Systems, a company he built through hard work, dedication, and integrity.
