Robert Leroy Wohlfiel, age 91, of Lake Orion (formerly of Royal Oak), passed away on August 2, 2025. He was born on June 25, 1934 in Detroit to Clarence and Carrie Wohlfiel.

Robert was raised in Royal Oak and graduated from Royal Oak High School in 1952, where he stood out as a talented athlete, excelling in both basketball and baseball. Shortly after finishing high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps.

Following his military service, Robert returned to Michigan and pursued a degree in business administration at Eastern Michigan University, supported by the G.I. Bill. In 1959, during his college years, he married his high school sweetheart, Florence. The newlyweds lived in "married housing" on campus during the early days of their marriage. Robert earned his bachelor's degree in 1961, and the couple soon settled in Royal Oak to begin their family. Robert and Florence were avid social bowlers who cherished time with friends.

Robert spent most of his professional life working in real estate. Outside of work, he was an enthusiastic sports fan who enjoyed watching nearly any game, though golf was by far his favorite — both to play and to watch. He enjoyed spending time with friends whether sharing a meal, stopping by for a visit or going on a special outing. He also had a keen interest in coin collecting

and loved working on puzzles. He was an avid reader who enjoyed a variety of genres.

Above all, Robert cherished his role as a father and grandfather, and in his later years, nothing brought him more joy than spending time with his grandchildren.

Robert will be remembered as the loving father of Karen Nasello, Robert Wohlfiel, Eric Wohlfiel, and Christa (Jon) Ryland. Proud grandfather of Cole, Sage, Teagan, Cameron, and Reagan. Dear brother of Bonnie (Ralph) Bekaert. He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Florence.
