Rodney Crowell, age 62, of Macomb Township, Michigan, passed away on Friday, February 9, 2024, in Royal Oak, Michigan, surrounded by loved ones. He was born on March 29, 1961, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Charles and Mary (nee' Fuqua) Crowell. Rodney graduated from Avondale High School in Auburn Hills, Michigan, in 1979, where he laid the foundation for a life of compassion, dedication, and service to others.

Rodney was a man of many passions and talents. He enjoyed gardening, and cherished the moments spent with his grandchildren, relishing in their laughter and innocence.

A treasured activity was walleye fishing, a pursuit he shared with his twin brother.

Rodney was a beacon of hope and resilience for those battling addiction. As an active member of the Macomb County Alcoholic Anonymous, he offered unwavering support and encouragement to fellow members, embodying the principles of recovery and renewal. His commitment to sobriety was a testament to his strength and determination, culminating in the milestone of receiving his 12-year coin just a day before his passing.

In addition to his involvement with Alcoholic Anonymous, Rodney volunteered his time and expertise at the Macomb County Jail, extending a compassionate

hand to inmates grappling with alcohol addiction.

Rodney is survived by his children Tiffany Crowell and Justin (Ilaria) Crowell, whom he adored with all his heart. He was the cherished grandfather of Isabella, Lucas, Edmund, Eleanor, and Dea, whose smiles brought him immeasurable joy. Rodney leaves behind his siblings Randy (Kathy) Crowell, Phyllis (Dan) Roe, and his twin brother Ronald (Tanya) Crowell, along with the memory of his late sister Helen Carpenter. He was a dear friend to Donna Drzewiecki and will be fondly remembered by many nieces, nephews, and extended family members.
