Working in community food service at Clawson Manor, she forged lasting connections, finding joy in every interaction. She had a special place in her heart for seniors, babies, and dogs, showering them all with endless affection.

Sue's love of adventure and the outdoors was nurtured in her childhood memories of the family's summer home in Canada and bike rides through Huntington Woods. She cherished the ocean, and some of her happiest times were spent sailing and fishing with her father. Those cherished memories became stories she shared with her family, tales of water, laughter, and love.

Her sense of humor was as unforgettable as it was contagious. Sue's laughter filled every room she entered, and her sense of humor brightened even the darkest days. She was a talented cook, crafting delicious meals for Thanksgiving and perfecting pot roast for her loved ones. There was nothing she wouldn't do to bring comfort and joy to her family and friends. Sue was the best listener and would always know what to say to someone in a crisis.

Sue is survived by her beloved children, Kathleen (TJ) Moriarty, Tim (Joy) O'Rourke, Colleen (Brian) Taylor, and Terrienne (Andy) Gould, each of whom she cherished deeply.
