On these calls they'd laugh, she'd offer calming words when they would get angry at traffic and share their hopes and dreams for the future. She loved to hear stories about her grandchildren and loved the photos and videos they would share.

Over the past 15 years of her life she devoted her time to caring for Paul as he battled COPD and other health issues. She made it her mission to make him as happy and comfortable as she could for as long as possible. Her heart broke when she lost him in October 2021. After his passing she struggled greatly with her broken heart. On good days

She left the world without warning, with planned adventures never gone on. Her passing has broken many hearts. She will be missed greatly by all that knew her.
