



Sam Anthony Romano

May 14, 1930 - August 31, 2024

Sam Anthony Romano, age 94, of Royal Oak, passed away on August 31, 2024. He was born on May 14, 1930, in Hollywood, Pennsylvania, to Epazzio and Tressa Romano.

Sam attended Windber High School in Pennsylvania before earning his bachelor's degree from Shippensburg University, where he was an accomplished football player and wrestler. Following graduation, Sam proudly served his country in the Army during the Korean War.

After his service, Sam moved to Detroit, where he began his career with Ford Motor Company. He later worked as a chemist for General Motors, dedicating 31 years to the company.

A man of deep Catholic faith, Sam was an active member of the Knights of Columbus and the Shrine Dad's Club. He taught catechism through the CCD program for 12 years and served as an altar server for funeral Masses at Shrine. His faith extended beyond his own practice; he encouraged others by praying with veterans and prisoners.

In addition to his spiritual commitments, Sam contributed to his community by coaching a city soccer league team. His legacy is one of devotion to his faith, his family, and his community.

Sam will be remembered as the beloved husband of Dorothy Barbara (née Tomaszewski). Loving father of Paul, Therese, Walt (Cindy), Carmela (James) Gillette, Joseph (Melissa), Peter (Denice), and Dominic (Anna). Proud grandfather of Taylor, Clare (Dan) Tresnak, Dominic, Kendall (Steven) Katofiasc, Patrick, Joseph (Lauren), Daniel (Hannah), Sophia, Isaac, Casper, Rowan, and Sam; and great-grandfather of Leo and Isaiah.
