At the time, I was simply looking up an old friend that I'd lost contact with to try and re-connect only to find out that he had passed years before. Anyway, I just felt the need to comment now bc I miss him and I might have some unique and new stories for Scott's fellow loved ones here. In a word, Scott was hilarious. He generated so many funny moments for us as we were both trying to turn our lives around in the early 2000's... Levity that we sorely needed at that time in our lives. We met at a halfway house for recovering addicts in 2002. Now, people approach recovery in different ways, some are eager to turn their lives around and jump right in and some are just showing up, doing the work and staying sober hoping they eventually see the light. We were the latter. There are a few though who take it so far that they believe themselves to be "recovered" right away and they are the most knowledgeable on what you need to do for your recovery and how to "work your program" when they themselves only have about two weeks sober, no job or prospects and really nothing going for them... and naturally, those types can be verry annoying. So anyway, there was a bulletin board near the halfway house office that people could post jobs on, offer work, exercise classes etc. So Scott decides to put up a post where he wrote "Anyone needing help working their program this guy can work it for you!" And he even did the little cut out phone numbers at the bottom like it was a post for a lost dog or something.. We were rolling. It was the funniest thing in the world at the time and the guy was put in his place and it was one of my first memories of Scott. I also remember him to have been a very sensitive guy with a huge heart. I mean, he looked like he could beat up a mountain, but he really was just one of the nicest guys around. We had a lot of heart to hearts, as one does when living closely in recovery with a lot of other people in the same boat. He was well thought out and always wore his hear on his sleeve. I just can't believe such a vibrant, hilarious, warm hearted person can not be alive anymore. Death just doesn't compute for a guy like this. He borrowed my Blink 182 - Enema of the State CD for about a year bc he liked working out to it.

I always think about him now whenever I listen to it. I'm so sorry for this irreplaceable loss for all of you too..
