Scott’s sense of humor was fast and witty – his laugh will be remembered by all who knew and loved him.

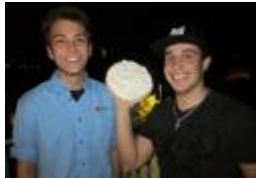
