



Seaber Callahan

October 26, 1915 - April 30, 2011

Seaber Callahan, age 95, a resident of Royal Oak, died April 30, 2011 at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak. He was born October 26, 1915 in Ricetown, KY to the late Albert and Mary Gabbard Callahan. Mr. Callahan was a World War II U.S. Army veteran. He was a barber at Cal's Wayside Barber Shop until 1967. He worked at Devlieg Corporation and then Chrysler Corporation until his retirement in 1980. He was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church of Royal Oak. He was also an ordained deacon.
