He was a 50 year member and past president of the Royal Oak Rotary Club and held a perfect attendance record. Also a member of the Shriners and the Royal Oak Masons in the 1960Æs. Mr. Snell spent time vacationing at his summer home in Lexington, MI and owned the A&W Root Beer store during the 1970Æs. In 1986, he opened SnellÆs Self Storage Units on Rochester Road in Troy with his late brother Barton, which is still in operation today. He was also a collector of model toy trucks and cars.
