Steven Paul Strickland, of Sterling Heights, Michigan, passed away unexpectedly on May 14, 2024 in Clearwater, Florida at the age of 31. Steven was born on February 28, 1993 in Clinton Township to Daniel and Mary Strickland. He graduated from Stevenson High School in 2011. Steven was born with cystic fibrosis, but he never let that hold him back from achieving his goals. Since childhood, Steven had wanted to work for Apple. For over 8 years, he made that dream a reality working as an expert at the Apple store in Somerset Mall. His life's passion, however, was a company he founded, Giant Helmet. These larger than life helmets can be seen not only through stadiums around Detroit, but in stadiums throughout the country. Steven was a true go getter, a hard worker, and he lived life to the fullest. When he wasn't in business mode, he was often spending time with his beloved family or his many friends. When Steven wanted to get away to unwind, he was often found on Clearwater Beach in Florida, soaking up the sunshine. Steven touched so many lives. He had an appeal about him that brought people around. Most everyone that met Steven, left as a friend. He will be missed by many.

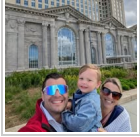

“ I first met Steve when I worked with the Detroit Red Wings in 2015/2016 and we worked together to get a Giant Helmet at Joe Louis Arena. We lost touch a few years later when I left the Red Wings, and he continued fighting on to grow Giant Helmet while dealing with medical challenges.

I didn't hear from him for a few years, but then we recently reconnected when he reached out and hired my marketing agency to help with Giant Helmet again in 2023.

We worked together since last June, as I helped build him a new website, develop a new base signage system working with the Detroit Lions, and launch the "Part of the Art" initiative with Oxford High School.

We were on Zoom calls when he'd cough up blood. He would send work emails from the hospital at all hours of the night. He had a mission to make a lasting impact on the community and he wouldn't let anything stop him. For the record, I believe he accomplished that mission.

Besides his relentless positive attitude on a professional level, I'm really glad we reconnected because we immediately struck up a good friendship on a personal level and were texting/talking regularly until last week.

I respect him and his tenacious work ethic. He never stopped fighting. He was diving around the gym at his annual dodgeball birthday party this past February and I'm so proud of him and everything he accomplished. You'll be missed, buddy.

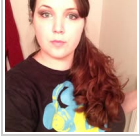

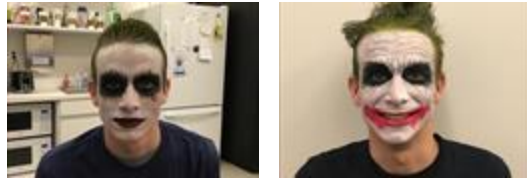
