



## Thomas Kennedy

May 15, 1941 - September 2, 2024

Thomas Ross Kennedy, age 83, of Royal Oak, passed away on September 2, 2024.

Tom was born in Detroit on May 15, 1941 to Roscoe and Iva Kennedy, and grew up in Westland. He graduated with his bachelor's degree from Michigan State University and with his master's degree from Wayne State University.

Tom dedicated over 35 years of his professional life to the State of Michigan, where he served in various roles, including employment counselor, vocational rehabilitation counselor, and adult foster care licensing consultant and supervisor. His career was marked by a commitment to helping others and making a positive impact.

Outside of work, Tom was dedicated to his family and community. He was an active member of the Shrine Dad's Club for many years and gave generously of his time with St. Vincent de Paul conference at Shrine. He enjoyed traveling and, along with his wife Christine, explored the country in her parents' 1959 Classic Airstream, visiting both family and countless national parks. Closer to home, his grandchildren were a special joy, bringing him endless happiness each day.

Outside of his family, Tom's second love was his 1966 Pontiac Catalina

Convertible. With the help of his son Ryan, he lovingly restored the car over two years. The Woodward Dream Cruise and Clawson Car Show became his favorite time of the year when he could showcase his beloved car and celebrate his passion for classic automobiles.
