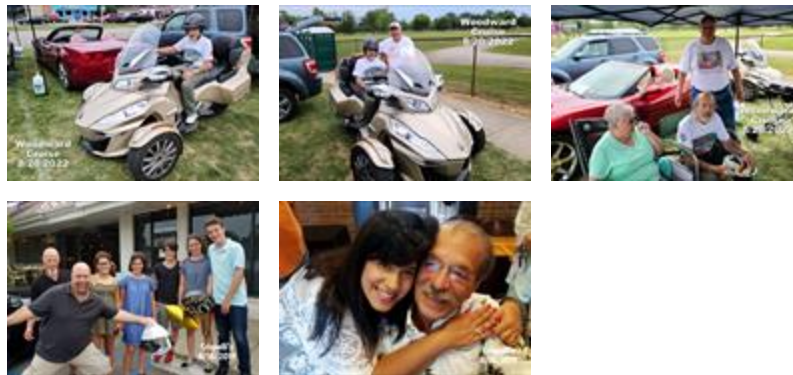

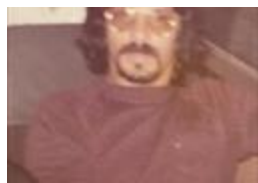

Tom loved his music also. I knew Tom through my brother in law , Carl

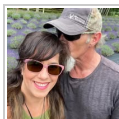
