I know these last several years have been very hard on him fighting stage 4 lung cancer and COPD, but he never complained. His oncologist, Dr. Ashkar would say you are amazing, you are strong like a bull. I remember when we

first started going to his oncologist appointments, I always was doing all the talking asking questions and the doctor told me from the very beginning. This is about Tom. You are bossy, but he is the boss and Tom would say that's ok she's got this.

When I could see he was feeling worse than normal, I would ask him to please tell me what was going on so I could help him. He would always say I'm fine, just not feeling too good today. And I know it was very hard for him to ask for help. He was a strong man, a proud man. But he would say it so often how appreciative for everything we did for him. Never just took it for granted.

He has left me with so many memories that I know in the coming days/years will give me solace and bring a smile to my face when I think of them.
