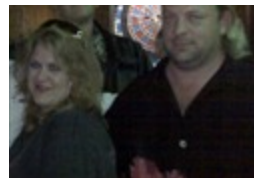

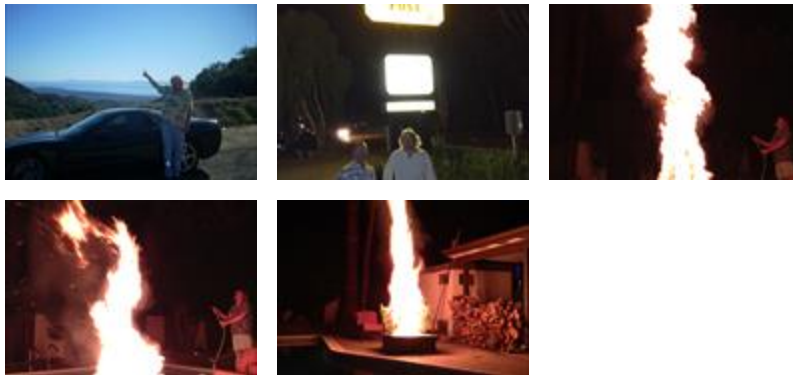

Still have a little stain glass kite he gave me for my birthday. It was a pleasure to have a fellow employee like Tim working for Joe and company.

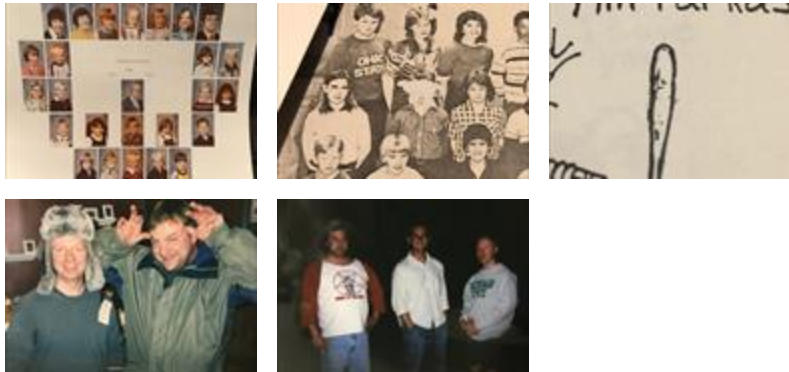

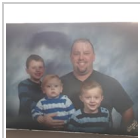
