Tincy L. Weirauch (nee Rudolph) age 88, passed away on February 16, 2018. Tincy was born to William and Allie Rudolph on January 10, 1930 in Detroit, Michigan. She was the oldest of three children. They grew up on the east side of Detroit, and Tincy graduated from Southeastern High School in 1948. Tincy worked at Blue Cross Insurance Company in downtown Detroit for a few years after high school. Tincy met the love of her life, Carl R. Weirauch at Vanity Ballroom in Detroit. They made their love eternal, and were wed on December 26, 1953.

Because Carl was in the service, Tincy and Carl traveled after they were married. They made stops in Texas and California. In 1954, the two welcomed their first addition to their family, a son, Dirk. Soon after, Carl's time in the service ended, and they settled in Michigan. They bought a house in Sterling Heights, where they resided for 60 years. A few years later, in 1957, their second addition came along, another son, Craig. In 1968 they completed their family with a son, Todd.

Some of Tincy's favorite things to do were to take longer trips and spend time with their family at the family cottage in Sebewaing, Michigan. She also loved to plant flowers and maintain her gardens during the summertime. Tincy also enjoyed bowling, where she was in a local league for many years.

As the years passed, Carl and Tincy enjoyed traveling. They would go up north to the Traverse City area with their Airstream trailer. They would also take trips around the country, visiting various states throughout the years.

Above all, family was the highest priority to Tincy. When she was younger, she enjoyed her children. She showed all of them how to cook and clean, as well as teaching them how to sew. A little later in life, she loved to spend time with her grandchildren.

In 2011, Carl passed away after 58 years of marriage.

During the last few years of her life, Tincy became a resident of Sanctuary at Bellbrook Assisted Living facility in Rochester, Michigan. All of the staff adored her, and she made many friends with the other residents there.
