Tom Hopp, a devoted husband, loving father, and cherished grandfather, passed away peacefully at his residence in Shelby Township, Michigan, on Tuesday, August 1, 2023, at the age of 83.

Tom was born on November 22, 1939, in Detroit, Michigan, to his late parents, William and Genevieve Hopp (nee' Gerwatowski).
