I still have the group photo of all of us that were there. My Dad took pictures of couples on the Moonlight Cruise but would bring the family to the Island a few times a year & Bill & his brothers would give my Dad a roll of free tickets for me & my sister or a friend & we'd ride all day & have so much fun. My Bob-lo memories are the best. Bill & his brothers did such a great job making so many people happy year after year & did such a wonderful jjob keeping the boat looking beautiful & the Island clean & super fun. Once I got into high school, I worked over there as a photographer too for a couple yrs, taking pictures of people on the Elephant ride &. Bill & his brothers let me & some of the gals that worked at the Zoo spend the night on the Island. We slept in a trailer located mid park. Late at night, we thought we'd go for a walk but a few guards with dogs came up to us & said we had to get back into the trailer so we did & went to sleep. On another evening, after working all day (my sister worked on the Island too taking pictures of kids sitting on a pony & we had our own pony brought over to the island for her to do that) my sister & a few gals rom the Zoo, took the ponies out of the barn & road them down to white sands beach & road them right into the lake. What great fun that was, galloping bare back except for one pony that would only go into a fast trot & it was hilarious to watch the girl on its back bouncing up & down up & down really fast. We all had a great laugh. But I'm glad I was able to bring all of the photo's that my father took of Bob-lo Island rides & the Boats & of one of Bill's Dad collecting tickets at the ole Woodward Ave boat dock & show the photo's to Bill & Ralph. And if I remember correctly, Bill wanted me to print up all the photo's & provide the family with them. If I haven't done so, I would be glad to & ship them out to you. God bless the Browning family & my heart goes out to you. Bill was a great man & will be remembered as that by me & so many many others.
