He spent over 50 years with his beloved wife Sandra. He was always very proud of all of his children. He was a member of Royal Oak Church and in 2022 accepted Christ as his Savior and was baptized at the church. After a long battle with kidney failure, he is now free from pain and is at rest and reunited with his daughter.
