William R. Chalk, age 82, died February 15, 2020 in Royal Oak. He was born on October 2, 1937 in Detroit to Bernard and Helen Gladney (nee Martin) Chalk. Bill attended school at Visitation Catholic School (Detroit), Bucklin School (Bucklin, MO), Blessed Sacrament (Detroit), St. Theresa (Detroit), Norborn High School (Norborn, MO) and graduated from St. James High School (Ferndale) in 1956. In October 1956 he joined the US Air Force and proudly served his country. 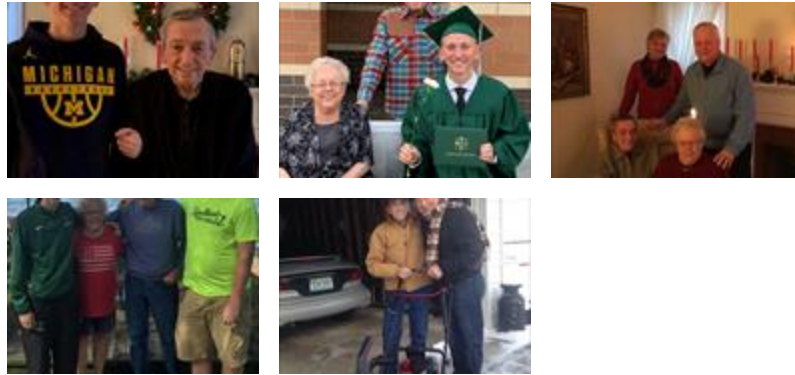
