William C. Rees Jr., age 75, of Royal Oak, passed away on November 6, 2023.

William was born in Detroit, and grew up in Romulus. He graduated from Romulus High School and then joined the U.S. Army, where he served as an armor crewman. He became qualified in various armored vehicles, but the M60 tank was by far his favorite. William would go on to complete a second enlistment with the Army a few years later, this time as a technician with the Pershing missile system. William was very proud of his military service and the expertise he gained, which he credited with shaping his life.

In his free time, William loved to learn. He was an avid reader who attributed his education to the public library. He also completed various courses through Henry Ford College and Eastern Michigan University. He was especially passionate about history-everything from Roman times to World War II he could speak on. And though he could at times be a bit ornery, he had a wry sense of humor that many appreciated. Above all else, William deeply loved his family, and he will be dearly missed.

William is survived by his beloved wife, Mary; his loving children: Jennifer Rees, Rebecca (Pearce) Murray, Sarah (Nathan) Wheeling, and Aaron Rees; his grandchildren: Hannah and Benjamin Wheeling; his faithful companion,
