Wynne Selke, age 57, passed away April 23, 2018 in Sterling Heights, Michigan after an unexpected discovery of stage IV lung cancer. Wynne was born May 27, 1960 to Carl and Ruth "Dorene" Anderson in Royal Oak, Michigan. In 1978, Wynne graduated from Royal Oak Kimball High School. In 1993, Wynne graduated from Oakland University with a BA in Communications. Wynne was an office manager for 15 years to the head of the OB/GYN department at Hutzel Hospital/Detroit Medical Center. Wynne married the love of her life, Greg Selke, on July 17, 1992 in the Martha Mary Chapel at Greenfield Village in Dearborn, Michigan. Wynne was always devoted to her family. She was a dedicated and supportive wife of Greg for 25 years, and assisted him in managing his diabetes. They met through the Detroit News "Companion Connection." They raised two daughters, Ava and Veronica. Wynne enjoyed and studied Psychology and human behavior--especially the writings of Carl Jung. Wynne was an avid, voracious reader; she especially enjoyed Russian literature from authors such as Tolstoy, Dostoevsky, and Chekov. Wynne was also an avid reader of the Bible. She enjoyed the humanities, and especially enjoyed art, music, classic literature, and classic films. Wynne admired and studied leaders such as Winston Churchill, Thomas Jefferson, and Abraham Lincoln. She was also an avid follower of politics both past and present. Wynne loved animals, and she has a special place in her heart for Boxers, many of which her family owned over the years. Wynne is survived by her loving husband Greg; her beloved

daughters Ava and Veronica; and her dear brothers Scott Anderson and Ross (Laura) Anderson. Wynne is preceded in death by her parents Carl and Dorene Anderson, and her eldest brother, Jon Anderson. 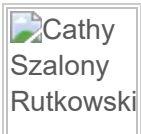
